Jesus is fulfilling prophecy (44-46) ...**



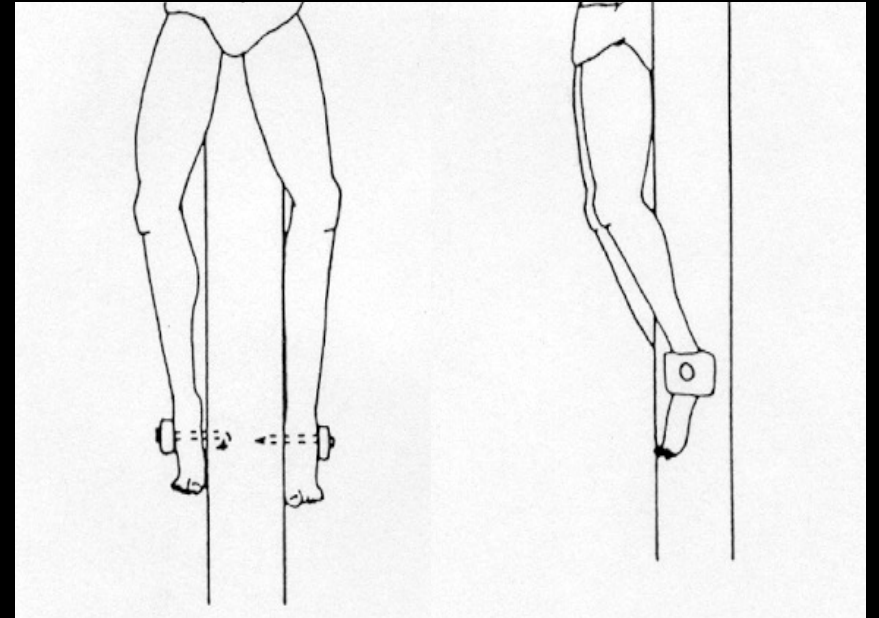
