The Old Testament Lesson: **Exodus 34:29-35**

²⁹When Moses came down from Mount Sinai with the two tablets of the covenant law in his hands, he was not aware that his face was radiant because he had spoken with the Lord. ³⁰When Aaron and all the Israelites saw Moses, his face was radiant, and they were afraid to come near him. ³¹ But Moses called to them; so Aaron and all the leaders of the community came back to him, and he spoke to them. ³² Afterward all the Israelites came near him, and he gave them all the commands the Lord had given him on Mount Sinai.

³⁵When Moses finished speaking to them, he put a veil over his face. ³⁴But whenever he entered the Lord's presence to speak with him, he removed the veil until he came out. And when he came out and told the Israelites what he had been commanded, ³⁵ they saw that his face was radiant. Then Moses would put the veil back over his face until he went in to speak with the Lord.


2 Timothy 2:14-19

¹⁴Keep reminding God's people of these things. Warn them before God against quarreling about words; it is of no value, and only ruins those who listen. ¹⁵Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth. 16 Avoid godless chatter, because those who indulge in it will become more and more ungodly. 17 Their teaching will spread like gangrene. Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, 18 who have departed from the truth. They say that the resurrection has already taken place, and they destroy the faith of some. 19 Nevertheless, God's solid foundation stands firm, sealed with this inscription: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Everyone who confesses the name of the Lord must turn away from wickedness."

THE GOSPEL UNCHAINED, PART 7 WATCH OUT 2 Timothy 2:14-19

Watch out for Bible teachers who make much of what is little and little of what is much.

When it comes to haggling over WORDS, cut it out. (2:14, 16-18)

Certain aspects of the faith are never worth disputing. (14, 16-18a)	
Certain aspects of the faith are always worth defending. (18b)	
When it comes to handling THE WORD, cut it straight. (15, 19)	
Aim for God's approval in your teaching. (15)	
Allow God to sort out the mysteries in his own time. (19a)	
Affirm your faith in God by turning away from sin. (19b)
