The Old Testament Lesson: Joshua 5:9-12

⁹Then the Lord said to Joshua, "Today I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you." So the place has been called Gilgal to this day.

¹⁰ On the evening of the fourteenth day of the month, while camped at Gilgal on the plains of Jericho, the Israelites celebrated the Passover. ¹¹The day after the Passover, that very day, they ate some of the produce of the land: unleavened bread and roasted grain. ¹²The manna stopped the day after they ate this food from the land; there was no longer any manna for the Israelites, but that year they ate the produce of Canaan.

¹Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

⁹ Do not be like the horse or the mule, which have no understanding but must be controlled by bit and bridle or they will not come to you.

¹⁰ Many are the woes of the wicked, but the Lord's unfailing love surrounds the one who trusts in him.

¹¹ Rejoice in the Lord and be glad, you righteous; sing, all you who are upright in heart!

The New Testament Lesson: 2 Timothy 4:1-8

¹In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I give you this charge: ² Preach the word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction. ³ For the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. ⁴They will turn their ears away from the truth and turn aside to myths. ⁵ But you, keep your head in all situations, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, discharge all the duties of your ministry.

⁶ For I am already being poured out like a drink offering, and the time for my departure is near. ⁷ I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸ Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

GIVING TO SUPPORT CHRISTIANS IN UKRAINE

Most of us have looked on in shock and horror at the invasion of Ukraine by Russian forces. Ken Sears, an EC missionary supported by Christ Community Church, has served in Ukraine for over 25 years. As you can imagine, his heart is breaking as he sees the destruction of the country he has called home for all those years.

We have all seen many images and videos flooding the news and social media with the devastation of cities, homes, and lives and the onset of a humanitarian crisis. The UN has reported that over a million refugees who fled Ukraine. In addition to a call to prayer for the nation of Ukraine, Christ Community Church has pledged to send funds to help the people of Ukraine.
