



<sup>1</sup>Then he showed me Joshua <sup>u</sup> the high priest standing before the angel of the LORD, and Satan <sup>v</sup> standing at his right side to accuse him. <sup>2</sup>The LORD said to Satan, "The LORD rebuke you, Satan! There are seven eyes <sup>1</sup> on that one stone, and I will engrave an inscription on it,' says the LORD Almighty, 'and I will remove the sin of this land in a single day.


No condemnation now I dread: Eternal hope is mine instead. His word will stand: I stand redeemed. The blood of Jesus speaks for me.
