Revelation 15:2b-3a, 4b (Responsive)

They held harps given them by God and sang the song of God's servant Moses and of the Lamb:

"Great and marvelous are your deeds, Lord God Almighty.

For you alone are holy.

All nations will come and worship before you, for your righteous acts have been revealed.

The Old Testament Lesson:

Job 7:20-21, 10:18-22

- 7:20 If I have sinned, what have I done to you, you who sees everything we do?
- Why have you made me your target? Have I become a burden to you?
- ²¹Why do you not pardon my offenses and forgive my sins?
- For I will soon lie down in the dust; you will search for me, but I will be no more..."
- ^{10:18} "Why then did you bring me out of the womb? I wish I had died before any eye saw me.
- ¹⁹ If only I had never come into being, or had been carried straight from the womb to the grave!
- ²⁰Are not my few days almost over? Turn away from me so I can have a moment's joy
- ²¹ before I go to the place of no return, to the land of gloom and utter darkness,
- ²² to the land of deepest night, of utter darkness and disorder, where even the light is like darkness."

we will also reign with him.


If we disown him,
