#### Call to Worship: Psalm 85:6-7

Will you not revive us again,

that your people may rejoice in you? Show us your unfailing love, Lord,

and grant us your salvation.

#### The Old Testament Lesson: Numbers 21:4-9

<sup>4</sup>They traveled from Mount Hor along the route to the Red Sea, to go around Edom. But the people grew impatient on the way; <sup>5</sup>they spoke against God and against Moses, and said, "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? There is no bread! There is no water! And we detest this miserable food!"

<sup>6</sup>Then the LORD sent venomous snakes among them; they bit the people and many Israelites died. <sup>7</sup>The people came to Moses and said, "We sinned when we spoke against the LORD and against you. Pray that the LORD will take the snakes away from us." So Moses prayed for the people.

<sup>8</sup>The Lord said to Moses, "Make a snake and put it up on a pole; anyone who is bitten can look at it and live." <sup>9</sup>So Moses made a bronze snake and put it up on a pole. Then when anyone was bitten by a snake and looked at the bronze snake, they lived.

#### The Response: Psalm 22:1-11

<sup>1</sup> My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, so far from my cries of anguish?

#### <sup>2</sup> My God, I cry out by day, but you do not answer, by night, but I find no rest.

<sup>3</sup>Yet you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the one Israel praises.<sup>z</sup>

#### <sup>4</sup> In you our ancestors put their trust; they trusted and you delivered them.

<sup>5</sup>To you they cried out and were saved; in you they trusted and were not put to shame.

#### <sup>6</sup> But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by everyone, despised by the people.

<sup>7</sup>All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads.

#### <sup>8</sup> "He trusts in the LORD," they say, "let the LORD rescue him.

Let him deliver him, since he delights in him."

#### <sup>9</sup>Yet you brought me out of the womb; you made me trust in you, even at my mother's breast.

<sup>10</sup> From birth I was cast on you; from my mother's womb you have been my God.

<sup>11</sup> Do not be far from me, for trouble is near and there is no one to help.

#### (PLEASE STAND) The Gospel Lesson: Matthew 27:39-49

<sup>39</sup>Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads <sup>40</sup> and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself! Come down from the cross, if you are the Son of God!" <sup>41</sup>In the same way the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders mocked him. <sup>42</sup> "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself! He's the king of Israel! Let him come down now from the cross, and we will believe in him. <sup>43</sup>He trusts in God. Let God rescue him now if he wants him, for he said, 'I am the Son of God.' " <sup>44</sup>In the same way the rebels who were crucified with him also heaped insults on him.

<sup>45</sup> From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land. <sup>46</sup> About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, *"Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani*?" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?").

<sup>47</sup>When some of those standing there heard this, they said, "He's calling Elijah."

<sup>48</sup> Immediately one of them ran and got a sponge. He filled it with wine vinegar, put it on a staff, and offered it to Jesus to drink. <sup>49</sup> The rest said, "Now leave him alone. Let's see if Elijah comes to save him."

<sup>24</sup> But King David replied to Araunah, "No, I insist on paying the full price. I will not take for the LORD what is yours, or sacrifice a burnt offering that costs me nothing."


#### [REPEAT CHORUS]
