Moving - We need to move many things to our storage area in the basement. These include both boxes and furniture. We will be giving instructions that day as to where and what needs to be moved.

If you have carrying strength - we need you!

Outside Work - We have many jobs needing to be done outside! Here is a starting list for the day. ***We need you! Please bring your own tools. Ask us ahead of time if you need tools for your tasks.***

1. Scrape and sand outside railings along sidewalks in preparation for painting.
2. Power wash entrances and walls to counseling center.
Power wash curbs around convenience parking lot.
3. Straighten any small leaning signs in the convenience parking area.
4. Picking up sticks and brush on property.
5. Weeding throughout property - we have lots of weeds that need pulling, so get your hands dirty! Most needed areas:
 - a. The parking islands of the main parking area
 - b. In front of the Park Avenue "oval" sign (flower bed also need reshaping)
 - c. Inside the 501 sign
 - d. Anywhere around the building
