




## The New Testament's Positive Statements about Old Testament Law


It is "spiritual" (Rom 7:14).


It is "holy, righteous, and good" (Rom 7:12).

It is true "we uphold the law" (Rom 3:31).









## God RESCUES his people through gracious salvation.


The Ten Commandments are anchored in divine grace.


The Ten Commandments are announced in divine glory.













## God REALIGNS his people through gracious instruction.
